a recommendation from a supervisor, principal, or peer concerning your qualifications.


Chaperone travel and homestay arrangements will be provided. Teachers or adults involved in a student organization are preferred applicants.

Chaperone responsibilities:

- interview students applying for the exchange;
- plan five one hour student orientations (assisted by Sister City Commissioners);
- attend a one night fundraiser at The Red Onion in Mountlake Terrace;
- lead the trip to Hekinan;
- present at an Edmonds City Council meeting following the trip; and
- assist with an orientation meeting for the following year's group.

Interviews will be held as soon as possible. Candidate selection is subject to Washington State Patrol and/or other background checks.

STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM WITH HEKINAN, JAPAN

Background Information

The Sister City Commission of the City of Edmonds arranges an annual student exchange to Hekinan, Japan. Since cultural understanding is so central to the Sister City program, this has proven to be the most valuable activity that we undertake. The delegation to Hekinan consists of up to 15 Edmonds students, ages 14 – 18, and their chaperones. In 2016, the group will leave Edmonds on July 20th and return on August 2. Student cost for the trip will range between \$1,600 and \$2,000, dependent upon the cost of airfare. Chaperone travel and lodging is provided.

This exchange is based on homestays for both Edmonds and Hekinan delegates allowing a high level of immersion for a low cost. Hekinan has been our Sister City since 1988 and their officials have enthusiastically embraced the relationship. They have been instrumental in developing our Centennial Plaza and the Edmonds Waterfront. Our delegates are treated like visiting dignitaries and shown many courtesies. The program offers opportunities for personal growth and expanded perspective unmatched in an academic setting.

Hekinan is about 30 miles south of Nagoya (home of the 2005 World's Fair) and is located on Mikawa Bay. The city has a population of approximately 80,000 and is a major port for the export of Toyota automobiles that are manufactured in the area. Hekinan is also noted as a fishing port and for the manufacture of ceramics and roof tiles that are an ever-present feature of the Japanese landscape. Nagoya is the third largest city in Japan and is ideally situated for the tourist to reach other major historic sites such as Nara and Kyoto. The Ise Shrine, one of the most sacred sites in all of Japan, is also nearby. Hekinan officials arrange for the Edmonds delegation to visit and enjoy these sites and many others during their stay.

Students from Hekinan will travel to Edmonds for 14 days in early August and stay with families of the delegates. The Sister City Commission arranges day trips and outings for the Japanese delegation to enjoy while they are in the U.S. Edmonds students and chaperones will have opportunities to join in these activities and help make the Hekinan delegation's stay memorable.
