

**ORDINANCE NO. 3671**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 1.02 CITY CLASSIFICATION TO ADD A NEW SECTION 1.02.060 MID-BIENNIAL BUDGET REVIEW AND MODIFICATION, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE SAME SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 3592 the City of Edmonds has adopted a biennial budget process conducted pursuant to RCW 35A.34; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35A.34.130 the legislative authority of a city must provide by ordinance for a mid-biennial review and modification of the biennial budget, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adopted. Chapter 1.02 of the Edmonds City Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 1.02.060 relating to the mid-biennial budget review and modification to read as follows:

**1.02.060 Mid-biennial budget review and modification.**

A review of the mid-biennial budget shall commence no sooner than eight months after the start nor later than conclusion of the first year of the fiscal biennium. The mayor shall prepare the proposed budget modification and shall provide for publication of notice of hearings consistent with publication of notices for adoption of other city ordinances. Public hearings on the proposed budget modification shall be heard prior to the adoption of the ordinance modifying the biennial budget. At least seven (7) days before said hearings, the mayor shall distribute the proposed budget modification to members of the city council, with copies available to the public at City Hall.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
