

RESOLUTION NO. 1147

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING EDMONDS' APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE "PRESERVE AMERICA" GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, "Preserve America" is a White House initiative developed in cooperation with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation ("ACHP"), the U.S. Department of the Interior, and the U.S. Department of Commerce; and,

WHEREAS, Edmonds is a designated "Preserve America Community;" and,

WHEREAS, the goals of this initiative include a greater shared knowledge regarding our nation's past, strengthened regional identities and local pride, increased local participation in preserving the country's irreplaceable cultural and natural heritage assets, and support for the economic viability of communities; and

WHEREAS, this initiative and the proposed grant project are compatible with our community's interests and goals related to historic preservation; and

WHEREAS, funding through the Preserve America grant program will enhance the Edmonds community's ability to protect and promote its historical resources; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This resolution states the City Council's intent to accept "Preserve America" funding if awarded and the City's commitment to develop a plan that will advance economic development using heritage and cultural tourism in downtown Edmonds and include a site specific plan for the 4th Avenue Corridor. The City states its intent to utilize and expend all

funds in accordance with the program and to maintain records in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for the inspection of the grant agency regarding use and expenditure of the funds.
