Effective January 1, 2020, Per City of Edmonds Ordinances # 4139 & # 4145



NEW Food Service Packaging Requirements

Effective January 1, 2020

- ◆ Ban on the use and provision of non-compostable food service containers.
- ◆ Ban on the use and provision of single-use plastic straws and utensils.
- ◆ Use of durables and approved compostable alternatives allowed.

Approved compostable alternatives indicates containers and utensils that has been tested and approved at a local commercial compost facility.

This applies to all food service businesses including:

- Full-service restaurants
- Fast food restaurants
- Cafes & Delis
- Coffee shops
- Grocery stores
- Home delivery services
- Non-Profit food providers
- Vending trucks and carts
- Farmers markets
- Institutional cafeterias
- Food vendor booths at public events
