Edmonds Historic Reconnaissance (“Windshield”) Survey Project

The City of Edmonds is presenting results of a reconnaissance-level survey of historic resources at the regularly scheduled Historic Preservation Commission meeting on Thursday, August 11th. Prepared by The Johnson Partnership, this survey project has expanded on an earlier (2004) survey of historic sites in the downtown area. The new effort supplements the sites identified in the 2004 survey by adding to the downtown inventory as well as expanding the historic reconnaissance into other areas of the city.

As part of this project, The Johnson Partnership surveyed more than 120 additional sites, identifying their historic merit and adding to the understanding of how they fit into Edmonds history. Although these new sites add to the understanding of the city’s historic heritage, surveyed sites are only formally added to the Edmonds Register of Historic Sites with the consent of the property owner.
