CITY OF EDMONDS SEEKS STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE TO SERVE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

(Edmonds – WA) The City Council is seeking student representative applicants interested in serving on the City of Edmonds Economic Development Commission. The purpose of the commission is to address specific issues related to economic development; help identify new sources of revenue as a direct result of economic development projects; create new strategies for economic development; and to provide recommendations regarding strategies for economic development and other matters that will improve commercial viability, tourist development and activity for consideration by the Edmonds City Council.

This appointment will be for a one academic year term starting September, 2012. The youth seat will be non-voting however you will participate in discussions and encouraged to comment. Community service hours can be arranged.
