EDMONDS CITIZEN'S TREE BOARD NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE

The Edmonds City Council just recently passed Ordinance 3890 allowing for the appointment of student representatives (students must reside within the Edmonds City limits) to the City's various boards and commissions as follows:

EDMONDS CITY CODE

10.03.010 Student representative authorized.

Any board or commission that derives its authority from the ordinances codified in this Title 10 may appoint a high school or college student to participate as a non-voting member of the board or commission. This person shall be known as a student representative. Student representatives may not attend executive sessions of the body to which they have been appointed.

10.03.020 Qualifications.

Student representatives must be residents of the City of Edmonds, but they need not attend school in Edmonds.
