CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

2014 Pavement Preservation Program

(Edmonds – WA) Snohomish County maintenance crews will be applying Bituminous Surface Treatments – or “chip seals” – to several local streets the week of July 21st.

This work – which is expected to occur on Wednesday, July 23rd – will apply a thin protective surface to the existing asphalt. This is a relatively inexpensive procedure that is expected to extend the life of the road by protecting it from the deteriorating effects of sun and water.

The work will occur in the following areas:

2nd Ave. N from Bell St to Caspers St
72nd Ave. W from Olympic View Drive to 176th St. SW
73rd Ave. W from Olympic View Drive to 179th St. SW

Residents should expect traffic delays in these areas and are asked to not park on the street during work hours (7AM – 5PM). Vehicles that are parked on these streets will be towed as necessary for construction.

Crews will return in early August to apply one additional surface treatment to 2nd Ave. N and 72nd Ave. W.

The 2014 Pavement Preservation Program also includes a 2-inch grind and pavement overlay on the following streets:

Group A:
100th Ave W from 244th St SW to Edmonds Way
Olympic View Drive from 88th Ave W to 76th Ave W

Group B:

76th Ave W from 174th St SW to 173rd St SW

Hillcrest Pl from Main St to end of street

211th Pl SW from 80th Ave W to end of street

224th St SW from 76th Ave W to Highway 99

The Group A streets are expected to be paved in August and the Group B streets are scheduled to be paved in September. An update will be provided in the upcoming weeks once the day and times of paving are determined for each street.
