APPLICANTS WANTED FOR DISABILITY BOARD CITIZEN-AT-LARGE POSITION

The City of Edmonds is seeking a person to fill a vacancy on the Edmonds' Disability Board. The position is a non-paid, voluntary position; any required travel expenses incident to service on the Board will be reimbursable. A medical background and/or experience is helpful, but not required. The five-person Board meets once a quarter (usually January, April, July and October) at 8:30 a.m. in the Fournier Room, at Edmonds City Hall (121 Fifth Ave. N., Edmonds).

Interested applicants must be a resident of Edmonds. Board members serve for a two year term and are eligible for appointment to additional terms if desired. The Board, as authorized by Chapter 41.26 RCW, makes determinations of reimbursement approval for medically necessary services for the City's LEOFF 1 retirees.

Application forms may be picked up in the lobby of City Hall (121 5th Avenue North, Edmonds), may be downloaded from the City's website (www.edmondswa.gov), or, received by mail by calling 425-775-2525 X1348 or X1375.

Deadline for applications is **Friday, March 28, 2014**. Applications will be evaluated by current Disability Board Members who will make a determination of appointment. Applicants will be required to participate in a brief interview with the Board for the position. The successful candidate who is selected by the Board for appointment to the position will be notified by Human Resources. The official appointment date of the position will be determined by the Board.
