Construction of the 2015 Waterline Replacement Project

(Edmonds - WA) The City of Edmonds 2015 Waterline Replacement Project is scheduled to begin construction the week of June 2nd, 2015. The project will replace existing waterlines, at ten different locations within the City,

The project locations are:

- Puget Drive from 9th to Olympic Avenue
- Sierra Place, from Olympic to 12th Avenue North
- Cedar St from 7th to 9th
- Daley from 7th to 9th and Aloha from 7th to 8th
- Railroad Ave, from the Senior Center to the intersection of Main St.
- Durbin from Dayton to Main, Main from Durbin to 7th and 7th from Main to Bell
- Edmonds from 10th to Olympic, and the southern edge of Hummingbird Hill Park
- 172nd St SW from Meadowdale Beach Rd to 69th Place W
- The intersection of 68th Ave W and North Meadowdale Rd
- 68th Ave W adjacent to the Community Clubhouse.

For reference, an overall site map is also attached.

The waterlines are nearing the end of their life cycle and improve overall pressure, fire flow, and capacity to the existing water system in the area. During the construction time period, we do not expect any road closures, but construction will affect the traffic lanes and flow of traffic at the various site locations. In addition, the installation of waterlines may require temporary shut offs to allow for the switch over from the existing waterline to the new waterline. If a shut off is required, notices with the time and date of shut off will be sent to the affected users 3 working days prior to the shut off.
