DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Amendments to Chapters 16.60, 20.01 and 20.12 of the Edmonds Community Development Code (ECDC) regarding design review processes and building step back requirements for certain projects in the General Commercial (CG) zone. These permanent standards would replace interim standards that were adopted by City Council in Ordinance 4283, which will expire on June 10, 2023.

Proponent: City of Edmonds

Location of proposal, including street address if any: This is a non-project action.

Lead agency: City of Edmonds

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

The City of Edmonds has determined that the requirements for environmental analysis and protection have been adequately addressed in the development regulations and comprehensive plan adopted under chapter 36.70A RCW, and in other applicable local, state, or federal laws or rules, as provided by RCW 43.21C.240 and WAC 197-11-158 and/or mitigating measures have been applied that ensure no significant adverse impacts will be created.
