DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Amendments to accessory dwelling unit standards and processes to align with House Bill 1337 as codified in RCW 36.70A.680, RCW 36.70A.681, and RCW 36.70A.696. The project would amend chapters in the Edmonds Community Development Code (ECDC) and the Edmonds City Code (ECC) to be consistent with the new regulations and other implement best practices: impact fees in Chapter 3.36 ECC; uses and standards in ECDC 16.20, 20.21 and 20.35; parking in ECDC 17.50 and 17.115; nonconforming code in ECDC 17.40; land use processes in Chapter 20.01; and related definitions in ECDC Title 21.

Proponent: City of Edmonds

Location of proposal, including street address if any: City-wide; this is a non-project action.

Lead agency: City of Edmonds

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
