HVAC Ducting

The Project

Equipment pads have been poured on the second level of the 600 building. Equipment is being installed as it arrives. Electrical work is being completed which will provide electricity to the motors on both levels of the building. Heating and ventilation ductwork are being installed in the ceiling of the first floor. The picture on the right depicts the temporary scaffolding that the construction workers use to install lighting, HVAC ducting and fire protection systems. Current project completion is still on track for start-up in December 2022 with full commissioning to complete by February 2023.

Odor

With the cooler weather, odors have been reduced but not eliminated. We have been covering the trucks every day and ensure that filled trucks are moved as soon as possible. The cherry odorant has not been used in the past month. We continue to monitor odors at the fence line and throughout the City to ensure we are doing the best we can to minimize our impact to the community.

Hauling

The truck traffic (solids hauling) should begin to taper down from December through commissioning. We anticipate all trucking of solids to be complete by the end of February 2023.
